National Registry Cognitive and Psychomotor Exam

Students are required to take the exam after successful completion of the comprehensive final exam. Student is responsible to pay for the exam when scheduled. All subsequent charges associated with failing the exam, or not taking the exam as scheduled, shall be borne by the student.

Admissions Procedures

Pass an entrance exam with a score of 17 or better within two attempts. If either test scores are between 12 and 16, an interview with the program director may be granted. The two exams must be taken at least 24 hours apart. Note: Vocational Nursing and Paramedic students must pass an entrance exam with a score of 19 or better within two attempts.
